## MEETINGS

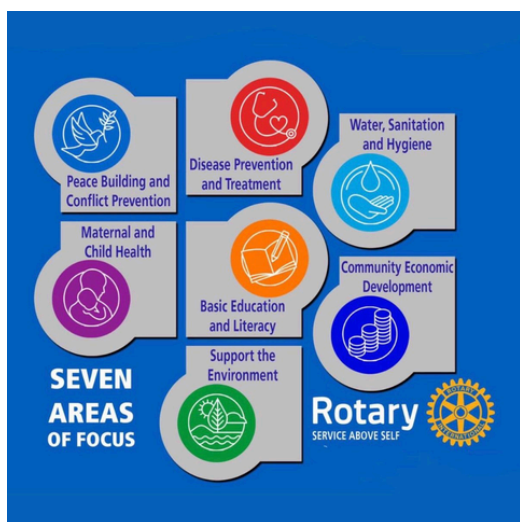
